Investing in the Communities that Make Our Cities Home

As this holiday season opens with tidings of joy, we reflect on a year in which Wilson Daniels prioritized giving back. Thanks to our volunteer initiatives, both the Napa and New York offices were able to spend time championing two very important causes: delivering meals to older adults and empowering under-resourced young women and girls. We are fortunate to have the opportunity and the time to invest in our cities and live out the Wilson Daniels values of passion, integrity, and collaboration through community.

New York is a city of movement: every day thousands commute to and from work, running errands by foot, by train, bus, and cab. For the older adult community, the fast pace of the city can leave them both homebound and suffering from social isolation. To address this, the Wilson Daniels New York office gathered on September 22nd to deliver meals in partnership with Citymeals on Wheels. Grouped into smaller teams of three, each group was given routes and delivered dozens of warm meals to older adults in our community. In total, our 22 employees contributed 66 volunteer hours and helped deliver 100 meals.

In addition, on behalf of the **Underwood Family Foundation**, Wilson Daniels gave a \$15,000 grant, covering 1,500 meals for older adults in New York City. This generous donation brings Citymeals on Wheels one step closer to its mission of providing a continuous lifeline of nutritious meals and combating social isolation for the 22,000 older adults in New York City. In similar step, the Napa office chose to highlight and support young women and girls from under-resourced communities, with an emphasis on foster youth. In partnership with **Project Glimmer**, whose mission is to help young women to envision and realize an empowered future, our Napa office gathered on November 19th to create gift boxes designed to inspire confidence and show care. Our team broke out into small groups to pack, wrap, and write personalized notes to the girls and young women who received the gift boxes. Thanks to our Napa team members, Project Glimmer continues to help their participating young women break the cycle of poverty while promoting gender and racial equality. Go Napa, go!

Sparkling Wine Offerings This Holiday Season

Bubbles around the holidays help keep the season merry and bright. Thankfully, Team WD has plenty of offerings to elevate any event, from a glass with close friends and family to larger evening festivities.

We are pleased to begin with the reimagined **Champagne Gosset** Cuvée Suzanne Rosé, a tribute to the president of the house (1955-1965) who introduced the first transparent bottle for a rosé Champagne in 1947. This wine complements the Grande Réserve, the "heart" of the range, offered in large format (3L) and perfect for group celebrations.

From **Domaine Les Monts Fournois** – a project from winemaker Juliette Alips and her cousins Raphaël and Vincent Bérêche in Ludes – comes the latest releases of Crus Sélectionnés Champagnes: Vertus Premier Cru 2010, Montagne - Bouzy Grand Cru 2013, Montagne - Verzy Grand Cru 2014, and Vallée - Aÿ Grand Cru 2013. Moving to the hillsides of the Vosges Mountains, **Pierre Sparr** offers a delectable Crémant d'Alsace Brut Réserve and Crémant d'Alsace Brut Rosé, both perfect for pairing with a festive meal.

Rounding out the imported sparkling wines are the 2024 vintage releases from **Bisol1542**, notably Cartizze, the 'grand cru' of Prosecco Superiore produced from the winery's seven acres at the top of Chartice, and **Jeio** Prosecco Brut Superiore grown from the steepest and best slopes on the hills of Valdobbiadene and Conegliano. Pioneers of fine wine in Sicily, the **Benant**i family offers two Carricante sparklings: Noblesse Brut Metodo Classico aged for 24 months on the lees, and Noblesse '48 Mesi' Brut Metodo Classico aged for 48 months on the lees.







60 Years of Schramsberg

On the domestic side, **Schramsberg Vineyards** rounds out a big year, celebrating the 60th anniversary since the revival of the property by Jack and Jamie Davies. We were delighted to host **Hugh Davies** in a series of 60th anniversary dinners across the country this Fall, with a particular spotlight on the tête de cuvée **J. Schram** trio – Blancs 2016, Noirs 2016, and Rosé 2017 – as well as a special release: the Reserve 2007 Late Disgorged, a Blanc de Noirs aged on the lees for 16 years in the winery's historic Diamond Mountain caves. These beautiful J. Schram cuvées are produced in limited quantities and complement the traditional **Schramsberg** and **Mirabelle** ranges, which include Schramsberg Blanc de Blancs, Brut Rosé, and Blanc de Noirs as well as Mirabelle Brut Rosé, Brut, and Blanc de Blancs.

We hope this holiday season provides plenty of opportunities to come together with those you hold dear, especially with a glass of bubbles in hand!
