Extremely perfumed with violets, black cherries and hints of bark. Savory and full-bodied with firm and fine tannins that frame the wine seriously. Notes of orange peel.

**2021 Pinot Noir U.V. Lucky Well Vineyard  
Russian River Valley**

Dark color. Lots of black cherry, umami, pine resin, oyster shell, wild berry and iodine aromas. Unique and full-bodied with powdery tannins that get firm. Tees this up nicely. Most likely heritage clones. Drinkable but will age nicely.

**2021 Chardonnay, Banfield Vineyard,  
Russian River Valley**

The brightness and fresh herbs, such as parsley and lemon-grass, come out nicely. Some flint. It's full-bodied with a lovely density. It has plenty of ripe green apple, lemon-lime and brioche flavors. So pure and beautiful.

**2021 Chardonnay, El Diablo Vineyard,  
Russian River Valley**

Lots of grape skin, subtle lemon curd and custard. Honey and blossom notes. Medium-bodied with a very tight palate and lovely depth and focus. There's tension and clarity in the extremely long, racy and intense finish.

**2021 Chardonnay, Russian River Valley**

Very clean and precise with sliced apples, light lemon curd and blossom honey. Medium-bodied with a crunchy palate of stone and apple flavors and a chalk-like texture. Lovely consistency and length, Crystalline at the end. A blend of all the vineyards used in Arista's single bottlings.

**2021 Pinot Noir, Russian River Valley**

Some blue fruit with iron and lavender character. Very perfumed. Medium-bodied with fine tannins and a bright finish. Linear and tight. Hibiscus at the end. A blend of declassified barrels from the single-vineyard wines.
