





ABOUT THE WINERY

RAVERA BAROLO DOCG 2019

The Elvio Cogno winery sits on top of Bricco Ravera, a hill near Novello in the Langhe area of Piedmont, one of the eleven communes in which Barolo is produced. The cellar is housed in an 18th-century manor farm surrounded by 11 hectares of vineyards. The Cogno family has been making wine in the Langhe area for four generations. The values of history and traditions handed down by father Elvio are enhanced by the freshness and innovation introduced by his daughter Nadia and her husband Valter Fissore.

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Cascina Nuova is the historical name of the Elvio Cogno estate and of the area where it is located within the Ravera cru. "Sweet blue berries, wild flowers, spring herbs and orange zests are some of the flavors that emerge from the 2016 Barolo Cascina Nuova. These aromas and flavors enrich a silky texture that creates an immediate and appealing Barolo, with sweet tannins, firm elegance and outstanding class." — Valter Fissore, Winemaker

KEY SELLING POINTS

- Elvio Cogno is the acknowledged leader in the production of Barolos from Ravera, a
 designated cru or MeGA (Menzione Geografica Aggiuntiva, which stands for singlevineyards in Barolo).
- Following in the footsteps of the 'maestro', Elvio Cogno, these wines are known for their elegance, terroir-driven and approachability with a very traditional winemaking approach.
- Elvio Cogno has been named "Winery of the Year" by Wine & Spirits Magazine for five of the past seven years.
