We finish the wine with small percentages of Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Malbec and Petit Verdot to deliver the best complexity and balance.

Varietal Blend: 91.3% Cabernet Sauvignon; 3.3% Merlot; 2.2% Cabernet Franc; 2.1% Malbec and 1.1% Petit Verdot

Barrel Aging: 21 months in 98% French oak with 15% being new | Alcohol: 14.1%
