

TENUTA SETTE CIELI



"Tenuta Sette Cieli," or "the Estate of the Seven Skies," is located between Bolgheri and Castagneto Carducci, on the Tuscan coast 1,300 above sea level. The 173-acre estate overlooks terraced vineyards and the Mediterranean Sea, and is surrounded by the lush woods of Monteverdi Marittimo. Seventeen acres of high-density vineyards are planted to Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot and Malbec. Because of Tenuta Sette Cieli's respect for nature, the winery has chosen organic practices to safeguard the environment. Everything is done by hand in the vineyards, with careful attention to each detail. The journey continues in the cellar where the winery employs single-variety vinification. Fermentation starts with wild yeasts, and the final selection of the wines is done only after a period of barrel aging in French oak barrels.

2015 YANTRA, TOSCANA IGT

Yantra (yawn-tra) is Sanskrit for "instrument" or "machine." A Yantra is a mandala — a map, chart or geometric pattern which represents the cosmos metaphysically or symbolically — a microcosm of the universe from a human perspective.

TASTING NOTES: The 2015 Yantra is characterized by an expressive fruitiness and pleasant freshness; it has nice acidity, and a persistent, interesting minerality. The wine displays soft, light tannins for a nice mouthfeel, and is ready to drink.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION: 60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Merlot



2014 NOI4, BOLGHERI DOC

NOI4 (noy-kwah-tro) translates to "the four of us." It represents the four members of the Ratti family, and is used at the entrance of their property. NOI4 was also the fourth wine added to Tenuta Sette Cieli's portfolio and there was a team of four people that chose to make this wine.

TASTING NOTES: A blend born of the desire to explore new territories, refined in barrels for 15 months. This wine is very expressive. It is characterized by a very elegant nose, fresh fruitiness, nice acidity and good persistence with an interesting minerality. In the mouth, the tannins are very soft and round.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION: 70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Merlot, 10% Petit Verdot, 5% Cabernet Franc



2012 INDACO, TOSCANA IGT

Critical Acclaim: 93 Points, Wine Enthusiast

Indaco (in-da-ko) is Italian for "indigo." It is often the color of the sky at sunset at Tenuta Sette Cieli.

TASTING NOTES: Malbec, Cabernet and Merlot come together perfectly in this stimulating, complex and structured wine, better expressing the complex and rich terroir with spicy and red-fruit aromas. Freshness, structure, persistence — this is a wine that preserves unchanged traits of the original season and terroir, intensified by 16 months in barriques.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION: 40% Malbec, 30% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Merlot



2010 SCIPIO, TOSCANA IGT

Critical Acclaim: 93 Points, Wine Spectator

Scipio (skeep-e-oh) was a famous Roman military general and statesman who defeated Hannibal at the final battle of the Second Punic War in 202 BC.

TASTING NOTES: The different lots of Cabernet Franc that went into the 2010 Scipio were vinified separately, resulting in a unique wine that seduces with its fruity aromas and spicy notes. This is complex wine of concentration, balance and finesse.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION: 100% Cabernet Franc

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
