ABOUT THE WINERY

The Elvio Cogno winery sits on top of Bricco Ravera, a hill near Novello in the Langhe area of Piedmont, one of the eleven communes in which Barolo is produced. The cellar is housed in an 18th-century manor farm surrounded by 11 hectares of vineyards. The Cogno family has been making wine in the Langhe area for four generations. The values of history and traditions handed down by father Elvio are enhanced by the freshness and innovation introduced by his daughter Naida and her husband Valter Fissore.

ABOUT THE WINE

Ravera is the name of the cru where the vineyard is located. This vineyard encircles the cellar, it is essentially the hillside vineyard surrounding the farm.

A wine that has a full-bodied, rounded bouquet of structure and balance. The persistent chocolaty aftertaste of dark cherry, forest berries, and black licorice is harmonious and enticing.

- The family’s current holding of the estate vineyards Ravera Cru represents 30% of the total cru, making them the largest landowner of this esteemed vineyard

TECHNICAL DETAILS

Varietal Composition: 100% Nebbiolo da Barolo, Lampia and Michet (*sub-varieties of Nebbiolo*)

Aging: 2 years in Slavonian oak, followed by 1 year in bottle

Alcohol: 14.5% | RS: 1.0 g/L | TA: 5.77 g/L
