TECHNICAL DETAILS

The 2017 RouteStock Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir derives from two different vineyards, one in the southern part of the appellation and the other just a mile and a half in from the Pacific Ocean

Varietal: 100% Pinot Noir - 28% Pommard Clone, 30% Clone 667 and 42% Clone 777

Barrel Aging: 10 months in 100% French oak with 10% being new

Alcohol: 13.7%
