### 2012 Château du Moulin-à-Vent: Couvent des Thorins, Moulin-à-Vent

“Vivid red. Smoky red berries, cherry and cured meat on the pungent nose. Lithe and spicy on the palate, offering tangy redcurrant and bitter cherry flavors and a touch of medicinal character. Finishes juicy and tight, with smooth tannins and a repeating meaty note.” **89 pts.** Drinking Window: 2015 - 2019

### 2011 Château du Moulin-à-Vent: Croix des Vérillats, Moulin-à-Vent

“Vivid ruby. Deeply pitched dark berry, cherry compote, licorice and woodsmoke scents show very good clarity, picking up peppery spice and floral pastille qualities with air. Juicy, penetrating and focused, with vibrant blackberry and bitter cherry flavors lifted and brightened by tangy acidity. Shows excellent depth and power, finishing sweet, smoky and very long.” **92 pts.** Drinking Window: 2015 - 2023

### 2011 Château du Moulin-à-Vent: Champ de Cour, Moulin-à-Vent

“Bright ruby. Sexy, mineral-tinged raspberry and floral pastille scents are complemented by suggestions of Asian spices and orange zest. Lively, focused and pure, with intense red fruit liqueur flavors that put on weight with air. Dusty tannins shape the finish, which clings with excellent tenacity and just a hint of fine-grained tannins.” **92 pts.** Drinking Window: 2015 - 2021

### 2011 Château du Moulin-à-Vent: Château du Moulin-à-Vent

“Brilliant ruby-red. Smoke- and spice-accented aromas of dark berries, cherry pit and licorice, with a hint of lavender in the background. Juicy, expansive blackberry and bitter chocolate flavors pick up a zesty mineral quality as the wine opens up. Energetic and precise on the finish, which features supple tannins and a touch of botanical herbs.” **90 pts.** Drinking Window: 2015 - 2021

### 2009 Château du Moulin-à-Vent: Clos de Londres, Moulin-à-Vent

“Ruby-red. Deeply pitched aromas of dark berries, cola and Indian spices, with a smoky mineral quality adding lift. Sappy and expansive on the palate, offering ripe blackberry and bitter cherry flavors lifted and braced by tangy acidity. Closes smooth, smoky and long, with supple tannins adding grip.” **91 pts.**
