2012 COLLEPIANO MONTEFALCO SAGRANTINO DOCG

BACKGROUND Collepiano represents the renaissance of Montefalco as a wine region and Sagrantino as a unique variety grown only in Montefalco. Collepiano is Sagrantino's area of production at Caprai. The name recalls the gentle slopes that characterize these hills.

HARVEST NOTES A vintage of low productivity which translates into an extraordinary quality of wines. August and September are warm and dry with diffused rainfall and balanced ripening. Wines of great complexity and aromatic structure. Prolonged ripening assured an optimal polyphenolic texture.

AGING 22 months in French oak barriques; minimum 6 months aging in bottle

ALCOHOL 14.5% **TA** 5.5 g/L **pH** 3.7 **RS** < 1 g/L

AGING POTENTIAL 10-15 years

TASTING NOTES Blackberry, clove, vanilla and herbal notes.
Extraordinary, intense and complex.



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
