## **94 POINTS - 2021 Le Clos Peyrassol Rosé, AOP Côtes de Provence**

“Vivid onion skin color. A highly perfumed and complex bouquet evokes fresh citrus and pit fruits, strawberry and pungent flowers, along with building mineral and succulent herb elements. Shows excellent clarity and depth to its juicy red fruit, nectarine and mango flavors, which are sweetened by a background of vanilla note. Finishes impressively long and silky, with the mineral and floral note resonating” — *Josh Reynolds, June 2022*

## **93 POINTS - 2021 La Bastide Peyrassol Rosé, AOP Côtes de Provence**

“Light orange-pink. Mineral-accented red berry and citrus fruit aromas are complemented by subtle floral and botanical herb accents. Juicy and animated on the palate, offering fresh cherry, raspberry and blood orange flavors that deepen with air and take on a spicy nuance. The mineral and floral notes repeat on the lingering finish, which echoes the citrus note.”

## **92 POINTS - 2021 Château Peyrassol Rosé, AOP Côtes de Provence**

“Translucent orange. White peach, strawberry, mango and a touch of honey on the highly fragrant nose. Offers fleshy red berry and pith fruit flavors, along with hints of lavender, fennel and orange zest. Closes long, smooth and gently spicy, with the peach and floral notes repeating.” — *Josh Reynolds, June 2022*

## **91 POINTS - 2021 Cuvée Les Commandeurs Rosé, AOP Côtes de Provence**

“Brilliant salmon skin color. Fresh and focused on the nose, displaying vibrant strawberry, nectarine and melon scents and a spicy touch of white pepper. Silky and open-knit, showing good depth and energy to its juicy pit fruit and red berry flavors. A hint of orange zest lends bite to the juicy finish, which hangs on with very good tenacity.” — *Josh Reynolds, June 2022*
