## 2020 GRECANTE GRECHETTO COLLI MARTANI DOC

### BACKGROUND

During the renaissance many wines were known as “Greco, Grecante, Grechetto.” Montefalco’s Grecante was one of the most appreciated. Indeed, the head of the Municipality of Montefalco used to send this wine as a precious gift to princes and important clergymen. Arnaldo Caprai’s Grecante keeps this long tradition alive.

Clay and limestone

Guyot

### HARVEST DATES

End of September

### HARVEST NOTES

Summer was well balanced with average temperatures. Standard temperature conditions during the key ripening stages of the grapes guaranteed a balanced concentration of perfumes and quality compounds delivering excellent complexity and aromatic and polyphenolic structure.

### AGING

3 months in steel; minimum 3 months in bottle

### AGING POTENTIAL

3-5 years

### ALCOHOL / TA / pH

13.5% / 5.21 g/L / 3.48

### TASTING NOTES

Intense perfumes of exotic fruit and yellow peach, floral notes of freesia and hawthorn, pleasing chalkiness on the finish. Full, fresh taste with a long persistence.



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
