ABOUT THE WINERY

The Elvio Cogno winery sits on top of Bricco Ravera, a hill near Novello in the Langhe area of Piedmont, one of the eleven communes in which Barolo is produced. The cellar is housed in an 18th-century manor farm surrounded by 11 hectares of vineyards. The Cogno family has been making wine in the Langhe area for four generations. The values of history and traditions handed down by father Elvio are enhanced by the freshness and innovation introduced by his daughter Nadia and her husband Valter Fissore.

ABOUT THE WINE

Cascina Nuova is the historical name of the Elvio Cogno estate and of the area where it is located within the Ravera cru. Born to satisfy the curiosity of consumers keen to have a more immediate understanding of Barolo, the wine is bright garnet red in color with orange tints. Pleasing and immediate, it offers scents of flowers and light, delicate spices. The mouth is agreeably rounded, juicy and fresh, with just the right balance between pleasantness and elegance. The aftertaste is very harmonious with a mineral, aromatic finish.

KEY SELLING POINTS

- Elvio Cogno is the acknowledged leader in the production of Barolos from Ravera, a designated cru or MeGA (Menzione Geografica Aggiuntiva, which stands for single-vineyards in Barolo).
- Following in the footsteps of the ‘maestro’, Elvio Cogno, these wines are known for their elegance, terroir-driven and approachability with a very traditional winemaking approach.
- Elvio Cogno has been named “*Winery of the Year*” by Wine & Spirits Magazine for five of the past seven years.

TECHNICAL DETAILS

Varietal Composition: 100% Nebbiolo da Barolo

Aging: 2 years in large oak barrels, followed by 6 months in bottle. Bottled without filtration

Alcohol: 14.5% | **pH:** 3.48 | **TA:** 5.71 g/L
