## PAZO TORRE PENELAS BLANCO GRANITO 2019

#### LEGACY

Layers of history and time are embedded in the solid granite walls of Pazo Torre Penelas, one of the oldest estates in the Valle del Salnés. The tower, chapel, and raised granary – Hórreo in Galician – recall a time of splendor, while the beautiful trellised vineyards around the property reveal a deeply rooted viticultural tradition.

#### 2019 VINTAGE NOTES:

In Rías Baixas, 2019 was a rainy year, and the water stored in the soil contributed to the optimal development of the grapes. Although the summer was generally mild, there was a notable temperature drop during the month of June.

#### VINEYARDS:

Varietal Composition: 100% Albariño

Appellation: DO Rías Baixas

**Soils:** The sandy textured terrain is made of granite rock formations where the soils have a low water holding capacity and drain swiftly. The soils derive from alluvial-colluvial Quaternary deposits.

#### VINIFICATION:

Fermentation: In granite vats under controlled temperature Winemaking: 2 hours of skin contact Aging: 8 months on its lees in the same granite vats, followed by another 8 months of lees aging in stainless steel Bottling Date: July 2021
