2019 VARIETAT RECUPERADA NO. 32 PIRENE

For over 30 years, Familia Torres has pursued an ambitious project: the recovery of ancestral varieties long believed to have been lost to phylloxera during the 19th century. In restoring part of Catalonia's viticultural tradition, the fifth generation of Familia Torres looks toward the future, seeking authenticity and producing exceptional wines with a uniqueness that makes them truly special.

Pirene, one of the recovered varieties, now grows in the vineyards Familia Torres has in Tremp (Lleida), at 950 metres above sea level.

2019 VINTAGE NOTES:

Overall 2019 was a rainy year. Most of the rainfall was concentrated over the vegetative cycle, whereas the ripening period saw normal levels of precipitation. As for temperatures, they fell within normal range.

VINEYARDS:

Varietal Composition: 100% Pirene

Appellation: Sant Miquel de Tremp

Harvest Dates: From October 15

VINIFICATION:

Fermentation: Alcoholic fermentation for 10 days in stainless steel tanks and 100% malolactic fermentation in barrels

Aging: 6 months aging in second year barrels

TECHNICAL DETAILS:

Alcohol: 13.5%

pH: 3.44

Total Acidity: 5.8 g/L

Residual Sugar: 0.6 g/L

Aging Potential: 10 years

TASTING NOTES:

A deeply pigmented red variety with high tannin levels, lots of red fruit, and a spicy, mineral nuance. The elegant palate reveals surprising texture and finesse, full of flavorful yet fresh fruit.
