STORY

Burgundy's vineyards date back to the Gallo-Roman era, but were abandoned for many years. Thanks to the monks from the Abbey of Cîteaux, well-known for the quality of their work in the vines and their knowledge of terroirs, these vineyards were developed from the XIth century.

VINEYARD NOTES

Varietals: Pinot Noir

Soil: Clay-Limestone

Viticulture: Currently undergoing Organic Conversion

WINE NOTES

Winemaking: The wine is vinified from grapes grown in the Domaine's vineyards as

well as selected grapes and musts from it's partner winemakers.

Quality controls are carried out to allowing the Domaine to ensure quality of the grapes and professionalism of the partner producers.

Barrel-Aged: 12 to 14 months in French oak barrels and stainless steel vats

Fining & Filtration: No fining and, light filtration using the lenticular module process

Alcohol: 12.5%

TASTING NOTES

Beautiful ruby color. This wine has pleasant, fresh, red-fruit aromas on the nose, which we also savor on the palate. It has rich and very ripe substance, with fine round tannins. It's a very well-structured and pleasant wine.
