### ABOUT THE WINERY

“ONE ESTATE – ONE FAMILY” | Wine runs deep in the Faiveley family’s blood, as they have been deeply rooted in Bourgogne, its history, and its culture for almost two centuries now. Their values have remained unchanged over the last seven generations and are based on a deep attachment to the Bourgogne region, an instinctive passion for the terroirs, and an innate respect for man and his work. Today they are one of the largest classified vineyard owners in Burgundy, with holdings spreading from the Côte de Nuits to the Côte Chalonnaise, featuring polished, collectible reds and whites with exceptionally high ratings. The majority of Domaine Faiveley’s vineyards are located in prestigious Cru appellations like Cote Chalonnaise, Cote de Beaune, and Cote de Nuits. Domaine Faiveley also manages to make about 80% of its wines with grapes grown in its own vineyards. The estate produces various wines across the appellation that include some of the finest Burgundy Grand Cru and Premier Cru wines.

### ABOUT THE WINE

The term “Cazetier” originates from “Castel”, the parcel situated just above the Château de Gevrey. It is one of the rare “Têtes de Cuvée” to not have been reclassified as a Grand Cru in the 1930s. Along with “Lavaux-Saint-Jacques” and “Clos Saint-Jacques”, this climat is considered to be one of the best Premiers Crus in Gevrey. The Domaine has owned half of the appellation since 2013. Fermented with partial whole clusters and daily punch downs for a 19 day vatting period.

- Situated in Chalky soils with white marl sedimentary deposits and south east exposure over a 4.06ha vineyard
- Currently undergoing organic conversion

“Deep ruby red hue with an intense and complex nose characterized by red fruits, toast, and subtle roasted notes. The palate is rich and round with a firm structure and direct tannins. This remarkably powerful wine offers a silky mouth-feel and exceptional length.”



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
