


DOMAINE DU ROC DES BOUTIRES

2021 POUILLY-FUISSÉ 'EN BERTILIONNE'



Vineyard | Exclusively coming from the terroir 'En Bertilionne', 0.57 hectares (I.4 acre), limestone interlaced with marl and chalk. The 'vielles vignes' of Chardonnay, located at the southern end of Burgundy, are planted between 250 and 500 meters in altitude, higher than the other AOC from Bourgogne. Thus, they provide both maturity and freshness to the wines. Vineyards face East/South-East.

Soil | Limestones with shoals of marl, a little chalky, very chalky deep

Vine Age | 45-year old vines

Vine Density | 10,000 vines per hectare

Varietal | 100% Chardonnay

Yields | 16 hl/ha (less than I ton/acre)

Harvest | By hand

Harvest Dates | September 21, 28 and 29

Vinification | The grapes are pressed as soon as the harvest arrives; the press is filled by gravity. Whole bunch pressing. Settling at low temperature (8°C). Slow fermentation at low temperature for about I month. Malolactic over 6 months

Aging | 30% stainless-steel tank and 70% oak aged for 15 months

Alcohol | 13.0% TA | 3.5 g/L pH | 3.40

Tasting Notes | Very complete and rich wine, good tension
